FATHER’S REFLECTION: Second Sunday of Advent

A particular message comes out clearly in the readings of today. Isaiah called it, the straightening and preparation of the way of the Lord. John the Baptist cited the exact words of Isaiah in today’s gospel, “prepare the way of the Lord, and make it straight.” The straight roads in the readings of today refer to our ways of life, such as a straight attitude, a righteous attitude, a loving attitude, an honest attitude, a forgiving attitude, and a just life. It is about the renewal of our life and reconciling with one another and with God. Advent, which reminds us of preparation for the coming of the Lord gives us the opportunity to pause and make our lives straight, so that the Lord will find a space in our busy hearts as we reflect on his first coming, his coming to us in different ways every day, and his coming to us on the judgment day.
