### FATHER'S REFLECTION: 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Ordinary Time

Undoubtedly, the first and second readings are about the situation of lepers before and during the days of Jesus. Leprosy was attributed to sinfulness and lepers were treated as pariahs in social and religious gatherings. Jesus reached out to the lepers against the false belief of the tradition and accorded them the human dignity they deserved and healed them.
