FATHER'S REFLECTION: 1st Sunday of Lent

Jesus went to the desert to be alone with the ALONE, or to have a quiet time with GOD. Satan, who hates actions such as proper prayers to God, went to the same desert to tempt Jesus. St. Mark did not give us a detailed story of how Jesus dismissed the devil but it is clear that Jesus was in powerful prayer in the desert and Satan was also dismissed. If Satan could tempt Jesus when Jesus was fasting and praying he definitely could do the same to us especially in a time of lent when we engage ourselves in stronger prayers and fasting. At those moments of temptations, may we join Jesus and tell the evil one, "get behind me Satan." The Jesus who was also tempted by Satan and knows all his tricks can help us become victorious over temptation. Let us, therefore, cling stronger to Jesus through our prayers and acts of penances, especially this time of Lent.
