FATHER'S REFLECTION: 4th Sunday of Easter

The difference between a good shepherd and a bad shepherd is the love that a good shepherd has for his sheep. Jesus is a good shepherd, and He loves us, His flocks. Nobody may adequately describe the debt of Christ's love for his flock, but the following general description of real love by Khalil Gibran could bring one to a closer understanding of Christ's love for his flock. Gibran wondered what actual love is and said that "all work is empty save when done with love. What is it to work with love? It is to weave the cloth with threads drawn from your heart, even as if your beloved were to wear that cloth. It is to build a house with affection, even as if your beloved were to dwell in that house. If you cannot work with love, but only with distaste, it is better that you should leave your work, . . . for if you bake bread with indifference, you bake a bitter bread that feeds but half of man's hunger. And if you grudge the crushing of the grapes, your grudge distills a poison in the wine. Work is love made visible".
